OHPS plans to purchase the following new costumes:

- 10 female costumes from the village of Zagori, region of Epiros.
- 12 male costumes and decorative chains from the village of Zagori.

In addition, the group will augment their existing collection with the following costumes and costume pieces:

- 6 female costumes from the village of Metaxades, region of Thrace, adding to the existing costumes.
- 12 (Aegean) island vests (male).
- 10 (Aegean) island vrakes, (island baggy short pants).
- 8 (Aegean) island male belts.
- 6 Male vests, village of Petrota, region of Thrace.
- 6 male belts, village of Petrota, region of Thrace.

These costumes will be owned by the OHFS, but will belong to the Hellenic community at-large.
